

## RFI – GAUL – Underwater Survey 2002

#### Summary:

Mobilisation of Seisranger and quay side equipment trials completed satisfactory. Vessel departed Aberdeen 1630 with full complement. Successful sea trials of both work class ROVs, observation ROV, and one LBV miniROV, carried out at a depth of 100 metres 11 miles south east of Aberdeen.

#### Progress over the last 24 hours:

Mobilisation on the vessel was ongoing in harbour.

#### Plan for the next 24 hours:

Now on passage to Bergen to take on fuel, stores and new marine crew with an estimated time of arrival (ETA) of 1800 hrs, 27 June 2002. We are expected to be along side the container berth for about five hours, before sailing for the wreck site.
